The Planning Commission will next meet on August 5, 2004.

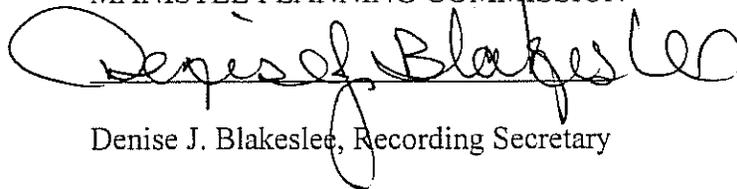
