

MANISTEE COUNTY P.E.G. COMMISSION MINUTES

JUNE 7, 1995

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRPERSON ANGELA MORIN AT 6:P.M. ATTENDING WERE WILLIAM SHALES, NANCY LEMIRE AND TOM KAMINSKI, EXCUSED WAS KATHY FENSTERMACHER.

MINUTES WERE READ OF THE MAY 10th MEETING, MR.SHALES MOVED TO ACCEPT SECONDED BY TOM KAMINSKI. THE MOTION CARRIED, MINUTES APPROVED.

MR. KAMINSKI READ THE SECOND DRAFT OF THE PUBLIC ACCESS POLICY THAT HE AND MS. FENSTERMACHER HAVE BEEN WORKING ON. EACH POINT WAS DISCUSSED AND A FEW CHANGES IN THE WORDING WERE MADE. IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT MR. GOCKERMAN WOULD BE CONSULTED AS TO COPYRIGHTS AND LIABILITYS. IT WAS ALSO DECIDED THAT WHEN THIS DRAFT IS COMPLETED IT WOULD BE DISCUSSED AT A OPEN FORUM BEFORE PRESENTING IT TO THE CITY COUNCIL.

A LETTER OF FORMAL COMPLAINT WAS READ FROM MR. CLIFFORD SELKOE. IT STATED THAT 1. HIS PROGRAM WAS NOT AIRED IN A TIMELY MATTER. 2. THERE WAS NO NEED FOR A DISCLAIMER. 3. COPYRIGHT RESPONSIBILITY. 4. HIS PROGRAM WAS NOT ON THE SCROLL AS TO TOTAL CONTENT. 5. PROGRAM DID NOT PLAY WHEN IT WAS SCHEDULED.

MR.CARLSON WAS ASK TO ANSWER THIS COMPLAINT AND HE STATED THAT HE HAD CONTACTED THE CHICAGO'S SCIENCE OF INDUSTRY AND SPOKE TO A MR. HARRIS WHO IN TURN KNEW NOTHING ABOUT THIS TAPE, BUT WHAT HE DID STATE WAS THAT MR. SELKOE WAS NOT AUTHORIZED TO TAKE THEIR TAPE AND MAKE A TAPE OF HIS OWN. HE INDICATED THAT MR. HARRIS WAS TURNING THIS OVER TO THE LEGEL DEPARTMENT AND THE F.B.I. WOULD BE INVESTIGATING. MR. CARLSON SAID THAT THERE WAS NO CREDITS.AFTER A LENGTHY DISCUSSION IT WAS DECIDED THAT THIS MATTER WOULD BE LOOKED INTO FURTHER AND IN DETAIL. IT WILL BE CARRIED OVER AND CLEARED UP AT THE NEXT MEETING.

MR. SHALES MOVED TO ADJOURN, IT WAS SECONDED BY MR. KAMINSKI. MOTION PASSED, THE NEXT MEETING WILL BE ON JUNE 21, 1995 AT 6:00 P.M.
